Bronze & Silver Award Courses
Auchengillan 4 - 5 March 2023

Bronze Award is the ideal qualification covering the basic skills needed for DofE Expeditions on tracks and paths.

Silver Award is for those with Bronze Award or an existing knowledge of the use of map and compass. It covers navigation away from paths and tracks,

Details of the Auchengillan Bronze and Silver Award Courses are as follows:-

Dates	4 - 5 March 2023.
Place	Auchengillan Outdoor Centre, based in the Training Room.
Times	9am to 5pm on both days. Full attendance on both days is required.
Catering	Bring a pack lunch on both days. Tea, coffee, juice and biscuits will be provided at breaks.
Equipment	Come prepared to spend most of the time outdoors. Bring waterproofs, warm clothing, walking boots or shoes, hat and gloves. Maps will be provided. We have some compasses but if you have your own or your Group can supply one, please bring it (Silva Ranger 3 or Expedition 4 are best). You may want to bring a notebook and pen/pencil.
Camping	If you want to camp overnight rather than travelling each day, the overnight cost is included in the Course fee.
Cost	£15 per person, including NNAS registration and Certificate, tuition and assessment by holders of the NNAS Tutor Award and optional camping fee.
